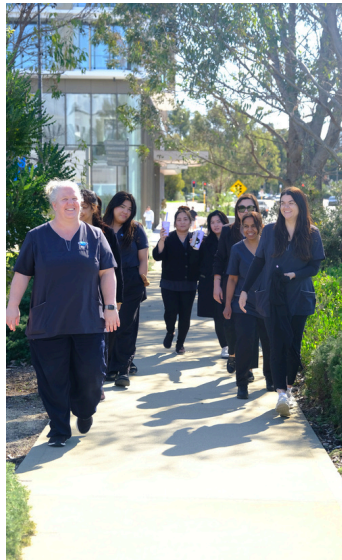


Every day, 57 Australians are diagnosed with breast cancer, and 9 people lose their lives to this disease.

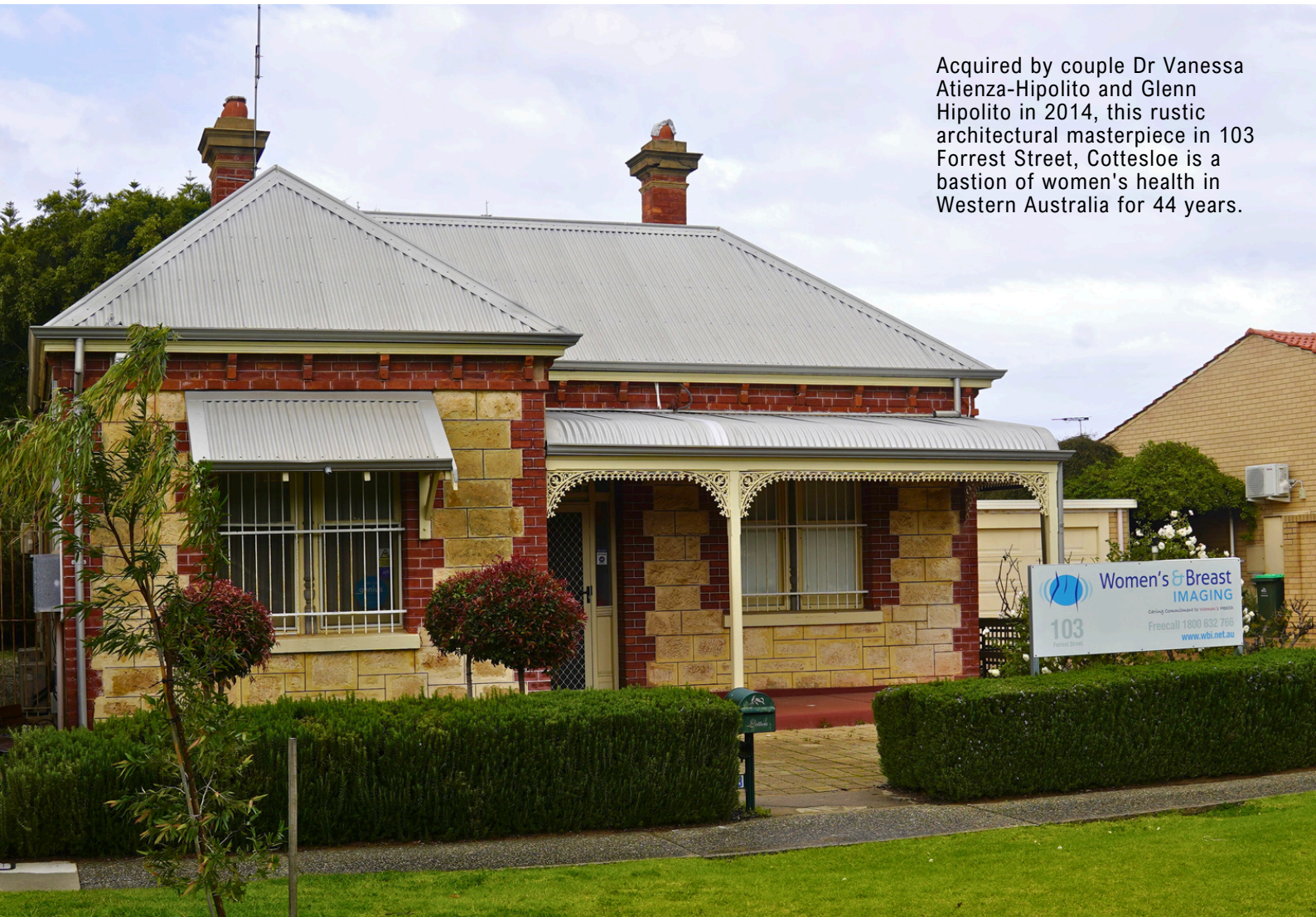

## A RUSTIC BEAUTY AT 103 FORREST STREET, COTTESLOE

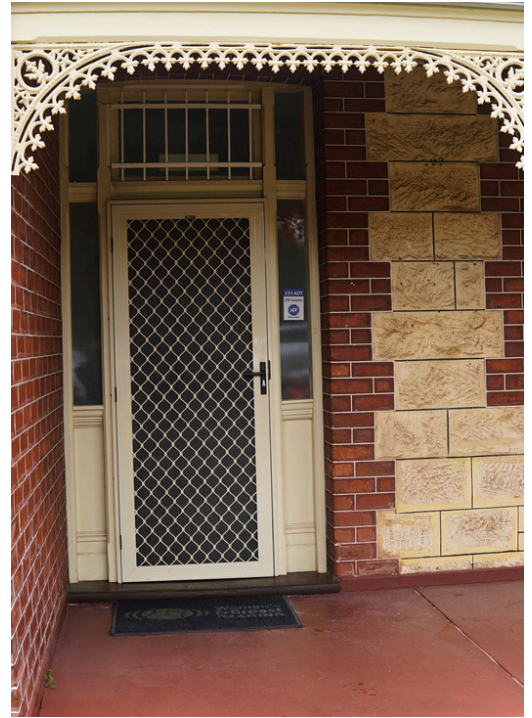
