This expansion aims to provide high-quality imaging services and other diagnostic procedures to a wider patient population, ensuring early detection and treatment of various conditions for all individuals.

V IMAGING offers a comprehensive range of general ultrasound services for both men and women, including:

- Abdomen, Thyroid, Neck, Renal, Prostate, Scrotum, Chest wall, Female Pelvis/Gynae, IVF work-ups
- Musculoskeletal ultrasound
- Obstetric ultrasound: Dating scan, First Trimester, Second Trimester, Third Trimester
- Vascular studies: AAA (Abdominal Aortic Aneurysm),
 Carotid, Upper limb (venous and arteries), Lower limb (venous and arteries)

V Imaging also provides a variety of ultrasound-guided procedures, including:

- Fine Needle Aspiration (FNA) of the thyroid
- FNA of cervical lymph nodes
- Joint drainage
- Musculoskeletal and bursal injections
